

Year 3 visit to the Science Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our exciting topic "Are We Lost in Space?" we have arranged for our Year 3 children to visit the Science Museum on **Friday 19th May 2017**. During the day they will get the chance to explore the Space exhibition and learn about the Universe. They will also be watching 'A Beautiful Planet 3D' at the IMAX cinema.

On the day your child will need:

- School Uniform
- Other clothing according to the weather - sunhat, a raincoat with hood etc. (N.B Sun cream should be applied before the trip).
- Children should bring a packed lunch with no breakable containers or canned drinks please. If your child normally receives a **free** hot meal then a packed lunch will be provided. If you pay for school meals then you must provide a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from **travel sickness** please give him/her any necessary **medication** before s/he comes to school on the morning of the trip and if necessary a spare to his/her teacher for the return journey. If your child does need travel sickness medication for the return journey please be sure to fill out a medication consent form available from the school office.

We will be travelling to the Science Museum via public transport and expect to return to school by 3:00pm. If there are any changes you will be notified by the school via text message.

Parents are asked to make a contribution of £4.85 towards the cost of this outing unless your child receives Free School Meals. The price includes the visit and ticket for the IMAX cinema. Although this is a voluntary contribution, I have to point out that failure to raise the required amount may mean cancellation of the visit.

Please make your payment and give permission for your child to go on the trip via ParentPay by Friday 12th May 2017. Please note that we are no longer accepting cash or cheques - lots of parents already use ParentPay to pay for meals, music tuition etc. but if you need assistance or further information please ask at the school office. Those entitled to free school meals are not being asked to make a contribution but do still need to give permission for the trip.
