



Year 1 Trip to Chalfont St Giles

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic 'How is South Harrow different to Chalfont St Giles?' we have arranged for our Year 1 children to visit Chalfont St Giles on **Tuesday 16th May**. On the day children will be able to observe the differences between living in a city and a town to support their learning in the classroom. During lunch, children will also have the opportunity to view a duck pond and explore and play in the town's playground.

On the day your child will need: School uniform and other clothing according to the weather e.g. a sunhat, a raincoat with hood, wellington boots etc. (N.B Sun cream should be applied before the trip).

If you would like your child to have a free school packed lunch (packed lunches normally include a sandwich, a piece of fruit, a cake or biscuit and a small carton of drink), **then please complete the form below and return it to the School Office by Tuesday 2nd May.**

If your child suffers from **travel sickness** please give him/her any necessary **medication** before s/he comes to school on the morning of the trip and if necessary a spare to his/her teacher for the return journey. If your child does need travel sickness medication for the return journey please be sure to fill out a medication consent form available from the school office

We expect to return to school by 2.30pm. If there are any changes you will be updated via text message from the school.

Parents are asked to make a contribution of **£4.70** towards the cost of this outing. **If you have applied to Harrow Council for Free School Meals and Pupil Premium for your child and meet their eligibility criteria, you are not required to make a contribution.** The price includes the cost of the coach travel. Although this is a voluntary contribution, I have to point out that failure to raise the required amount may mean cancellation of the visit.

Please make your payment and give permission for your child to go on the trip via ParentPay by Tuesday 2nd May 2017. Please note that we are no longer accepting cash or cheques - lots of parents already use ParentPay to pay for meals, music tuition etc. but if you need assistance or further information please ask at the school office.
