


Nursery Autumn Term Newsletter September 2018



Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome Heathland School and to the Acorns Nursery class. This year the Nursery teachers are Mrs Larman, Mrs Bhattraaj, Mrs Siva, Mrs Sathesh and Mrs Gromolich.

There are some fantastic topics of learning which will be covered in the Nursery throughout this term. Initially we will be asking the children the question 'Who am I?' This will give them the chance to express themselves, show their uniqueness and engage with activities that reflect their own personal interests. Following on from this, children will be investigating 'What they can see in the colourful world', where they will explore and engage in the world of shapes and colours and look at the exciting festivals that we will be celebrating during this term.

SOME IMPORTANT REMINDERS!

Arriving and leaving school:

It is important that your child arrives on time each day; otherwise they will miss out on important information and instructions for the day. Morning Nursery starts at 8:50am and runs until 11:50am. Afternoon Nursery starts at 12pm and runs until 3pm. There is an 'After-school Club' available everyday if you are having difficulty picking your child up. It is also important that they are collected on time as this may cause distress to your child. If someone other than yourself is collecting your child from school, please ensure that you have filled out relevant forms in the school office or provided them with the password that has been agreed with us.

Please also ensure that your child attends Nursery everyday so that they don't fall behind in their learning.

Labelling

Please make sure that all school equipment and clothing is labelled e.g. coats, sweat shirts, trousers, t-shirts, skirts, cardigans, shoes, scarves, hats, gloves, Wellington boots, and book-bags.

If your child borrows clothes from the Nursery please wash them and return them to the Nursery, so that they can continue to be available for everyone.
