NURSERY LIBRARY BOOKS

As you know we are having to do things a little differently this year. We are keen for you and your child to have access to the books in our class library as has happened in previous years. However, we are going to be setting certain days for the books to go out and for the books to come back in again. This will allow for the books to be quarantined before being sent out again.

Two books per child will be sent out in their book bags on a **Monday**.
The two books will be collected back in on a **Thursday**.

Please help your child to look after these books and make sure that younger siblings are not able to get hold of them. Keep them in your child's book bag when not being read to minimise touching. It is very important that the books are not written on, ripped or damaged in any way, as we are very lucky to have access to such a lovely resource.

If books do come back damaged or go missing then unfortunately a charge will be made.

Reading with your child daily has many great benefits, encouraging language and concentration, as well as being a lovely time to share with your child. An ideal time to read the book is as a story before bedtime.

Please also remember not to put your child's water bottles into their book bags as when they leak, they damage the books and a charge for the damaged books will be made.
