# EYFS Curriculum Newsletter

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Heathland School and to the Acorn Nursery class. This year the Nursery teacher is Mrs D'Costa and Mrs Bhattaraj, Mrs Siva, Miss Tai and Miss Riley make up the rest of the Nursery team.

We will be covering some very exciting topics in the Nursery throughout this term. Initially we will be asking the children the question 'Who am I?' This will give them the chance to express themselves, show their uniqueness and engage with activities that reflect their own personal interests. Following on from this, children will be investigating 'What they can see in the colourful world', where they will explore and engage in the world of colours and patterns and will look at the exciting festivals that we will be celebrating during this term.

### Some important reminders!

#### Arriving and leaving school:

It is important that your child arrives on time each day; otherwise they will miss out on important information and instructions for the day. Morning Nursery starts at 8:50am and runs until 11:50am. Afternoon Nursery starts at 12pm and runs until 3pm. It is also important that they are collected on time as this may cause distress to your child. If someone other than yourself is collecting your child from school, please ensure that you have filled out relevant forms or provided them with the password that has been agreed with us. Please remember to follow the social distancing rules when dropping and picking up your child.

#### Labelling

Please make sure that all school equipment and clothing is labelled with permanent ink e.g. coats, sweat shirts, trousers, t-shirts, skirts, cardigans, shoes, scarves, hats, gloves, wellington boots, water bottles and book-bags.

#### Class library scheme

The children will be able to bring a book home from our class library to share with you at home every day. Please make sure to return these books the next day so your child can choose a new one.

#### Parent Notice Board

Please read the 'Parents notice board' located on the wall outside of the Nursery main door, to keep up to date with forthcoming dates and details of any special request linked to our topics.

#### How can you help to support your child this term?

Read and talk to your child everyday about things that interest them.

Practise recognising and writing their name.

Look for numbers, shapes and colours when you are at home or out and about and have fun as you go!
