Dear Parent/Carer,

On **Friday 9th June**, we will be holding a **Spanish Day**, to celebrate our teaching of the Spanish language at Heathland. Children will be taking part in Spanish themed learning throughout the day, and Senor Puertas will be visiting each class to give them the opportunity to speak as much Spanish as possible. The progress the children are making in Spanish is something to be celebrated!
